

**RESOLUTION
OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE Victoria County Groundwater
Conservation District**

MEETING HELD MARCH 29, 2006

**A RESOLUTION TO REVISE THE BOUNDARY BETWEEN
GMA 15 AND GMA 16**

WHEREAS, the 79th Legislature enacted House Bill 1763 in 2005, which added Section 36.108 to the Texas Water Code to require joint planning by groundwater conservation districts ("GCD") in a groundwater management area ("GMA") and to adopt the desired future conditions of the aquifer or aquifers within their GMA; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to improve joint planning in their GMA the Victoria County Groundwater Conservation District ("VCGCD") believes that it would be advantageous to move the current GMA boundary dividing GMA 15 and GMA 16 south to the Aransas River extending west to include Bee County and extending west to the Bee County and Live Oak County line following that line west and following the boundary between Live Oak County and Karnes County ending at the western edge of the Gulf Coast Aquifer.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Board of Directors of the Victoria County Groundwater Conservation District hereby adopts this resolution requesting that the Texas Water Development Board move the GMA 15 and GMA 16 boundary line south to the Aransas River extending west through Bee County and extending west to the Bee County and Live Oak County line following that line west and following the boundary between Live Oak and Karnes County ending at the western edge of the Gulf Coast Aquifer.

The attached revised GMA 15 and GMA 16 map, as presented to this Board of Directors at the Meeting held on March 29, 2006, is hereby incorporated by reference.

Upon motion duly made by Director Kenneth Eller, and seconded by Director Thurman Clements, Jr., and upon discussion, the Board voted 5 in favor and 0 opposed, 0 abstained, and 0 absent, and the motion thereby PASSED on this 29 day of March, 2006.
